Dr Chris Olynik - Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Dr Olynik joined Island Oral Facial and Implant Surgery in the summer of 2013. He received his DMD degree from UBC in 2008 and then pursued his specialist residency in Houston, Texas.

Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons are specialists involved in dentoalveolar surgery, facial trauma, facial deformity correction, cleft lip and palate surgery, reconstructive facial surgery, cosmetic facial surgery, cancer surgery, temporomandibular joint management and surgery, head and neck infections and the management of other pathologies. Contemporary oral and maxillofacial surgery has been aided by new imaging technologies and virtual surgical planning allowing consistently better results for patients. Using cases, this lecture will review some of the recent advances in oral and maxillofacial surgery with a focus on interdisciplinary treatment planning with suggestions for effective provider communication.

Current and Future Trends in Prosthodontics**

Dr Keyes, who is originally from Victoria, attended dental school at Boston University, and completed a 3 year residency and master's degree in Prosthodontics at the University of Minnesota.



The practice of dentistry is dynamic and always evolving, especially lately with the revolution of digital dentistry. It seems that everywhere we look there is some new equipment or technology that promises to revolutionize the field and make our lives more simple. The amount of information available can be daunting, and there is often trepidation to adopt something new because of the difficulty in changing workflows and the fear that it will become obsolete. This lecture will provide a brief overview of some of the current technology and techniques in prosthodontics, and provide a glimpse into some of the future trends that are emerging in dentistry.

TMD and the Chiropractor**

Dr Kenmuir was raised in Powell River, and worked as a CDA for a number of years, before pursuing a career as a chiropractor. Dr Kenmuir graduated with honours from Life Chiropractic College in California and recently joined Long Lake Chiropractic in Nanaimo.



Dr Kenmuir will provide a review of neurology and the anatomy of the cervical spine and it's connection to the TMJ. The effects of airway obstruction on the cranio-cervical and craniomandibular systems will be discussed. Dr Kenmuir will also touch on dental ergonomics, and the long term effects that poor posture can have on the dental professional.
