*Dr. Jonathan Bower is a Board-Certified Specialist in Periodontics. He completed his dental surgery degree in 2007 and a postgraduate diploma in implantology in 2008 at the University of Western Cape in his native South Africa. He practiced as a general practitioner for nearly a decade in Cape Town and Johannesburg, providing a wide range of care, from complex restorative rehabilitation to laser dentistry, oral surgery, and implants.*

*He completed the Graduate Periodontics Program at the University of Manitoba in 2019 and is a fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. He resides in Nanaimo and is partnered in two multi-specialty practices where he performs full-spectrum periodontics, with a special interest in full-arch rehabilitation, on upper and central Vancouver Island. He is also a part-time clinical assistant professor at the postgraduate periodontics department of the University of British Columbia and provides continuous education to the Vancouver Island dental community through his annual hygiene and surgical implant study clubs.*

**FULL ARCH IMPLANT REHABILITATIVE OPTIONS FOR A FAILING DENTITION 3 CE**

This presentation will focus on the surgical and prosthetic options available to patients presenting with multiple failing teeth, be it from extensive restorative breakdown or as a result of severe periodontal disease. The following topics will be discussed:

**Timing of treatment:** When are we left with no alternative other than considering the replacement of natural teeth with implants?

**Case selection:** review factors affecting the long-term success of full-arch implant retained/supported prostheses.

**Prosthetic considerations:** Discuss the selection of the appropriate prostheses on a case-by-case basis.

**Surgical considerations:** A detailed delve into the surgical processes and limitations of “teeth in a day” procedures.

**Patient education and long-term maintenance:** Proper maintenance protocols and effective management of patient risk factors to ensure a good long-term prognosis.

**MENOPAUSE IN THE DENTAL OFFICE: PATIENTS AND STAFF 3 CE**

This course will cover why menopause care is so important and why all care providers should be educated about menopause. This course will cover the following topics:

**The menopause transition:** How do we define menopause and perimenopause; a “natural” life transition for women.

**Nuts and Bolts of HRT:** A review of the evidence and examining the “gap” in research on women’s health and particularly menopause.

**Misogyny in medicine:** How women are impacted by a lack of knowledge about menopause: pitfalls in how we apply research.

**“Risk” and patient autonomy:** Explore how the concepts of risk and informed consent are sometimes weaponized in medical care and specifically how this applies to care.

**Menopause and dental care:** An overview of how hormone changes can affect our oral health and what dental professionals should be aware of.

**Menopause and mental health:** Look at the difference between reproductive mental health (ie. Hormone changes causing mental health symptoms) and psychiatry. Why the way we view mental health and hormones needs to change urgently.

**Menopause in the workplace:** Discuss the issues that affect women and their ability to work as they go through menopause and how workplaces can support this life transition (PS. it is not about hot flashes & having fans).
